Grow your very own garden!

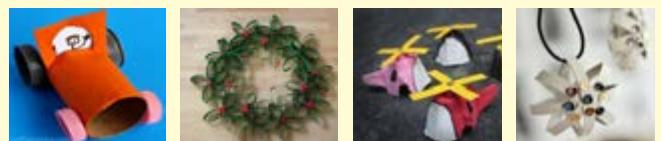
Recycle old and tired items like empty bottles and cartons to grow herbs and micro-plants that would look great on your kitchen windowsill!
